COMPULSORY REQUIREMENTS

- Physical Science and Life Science – for Grade 10-12 learners in subject stream - White lab coat.
- The Science stream may only be selected by learners who have passed Mathematics and Natural Sciences with 50% and above in grade 9.
- The Commerce stream may only be selected by learners who have passed Mathematics and EMS with 50% and above in grade 9.
- The choice of the First Additional language for FET, must be in line with the language the learner did in grade 9.

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM REGULATIONS:

No jewellery may be worn, apart from a plain watch with a plain face and plain black leather straps.

No tattoos or piercings will be accepted.

Hair must be kept in the natural hair colour.

BOYS

- Hair must be neat and short, (no fancy patterns, edging or fading will be tolerated)
- No earrings or piercings are allowed, this includes retainers of any sort.
- The school pants must not be altered in anyway and must be of a length that is just above the sole of the shoes.
- Ties must be worn in a manner that is neat and displays the conduct of a well-behaved learner.
- Shirts must be clean and neatly tucked in at all times.
- No suede shoes are permitted, shoes must be neat and polished.

GIRLS

- Plain studs may be worn in the piercing of the earlobe only. Multiple piercings and retainers will not be permitted.
- Skirts that are above four fingers from the knee will not be allowed.
- The winter pants must not be figure-hugging and must not display the likes of a skinny cut. The school pants must not be altered in anyway and must be of a length that is just above the sole of the shoes.
- Braiding of hair should be thin and at most shoulder length. The extensions must match the natural hair colour and neatly fastened into a single ponytail or low bun.
- Natural hair must be kept neat at all times.
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied into a single ponytail or a low bun.
- Only black hair accessories may be worn.
- Ties must be worn in a manner that is neat and displays the conduct of a well-behaved learner.
- Shirts must be clean and neatly tucked in at all times.
- No suede shoes are permitted, shoes must be neat and polished.

We believe that a disciplined individual is a successful individual and forms part of our motto! Unlike many schools we have been able to maintain the standard our order and discipline in our school thus leading to a conducive environment which sets our learners up for success.

When the matter of discipline is considered, it is important to taken into consideration that children are individuals that are still developing mentally and emotionally, therefore reliant on the guidance and mentoring of adults. Hence our method of discipline is based on these simple principles - "correction first, consequences later" and "Good works deserve rewards", which is monitored and recorded on a Merit and Demerit System.
